

SEARCH MODIFIERS CHEAT SHEET



WHAT ARE SEARCH MODIFIERS?

They are commands that help make your search more precise by refining and filtering your results.



ASTERISK

Use it when you want your search results to capture plural forms, different tenses, or different endings of the words.

Example: Chees*

Will search for cheese, cheesy, cheesiest, etc



QUOTATION MARKS

Use it when you are searching for a specific phrase and want all the words to appear in that specific order.

Example: "soft cheese"



BRACKETS

Use it with boolean operators to help dictate the order of operation. It is helpful when you want to use a variety of words, phrases, concepts and techniques in one search.

Example: (cheese AND cow) NOT ("soft cheese" AND goat)
